

Information Security Policy; ISO27001/ISO27799

The management of Savyon Diagnostics hereby adopts the ISO 27001 and ISO 27799 standards for Information Security Management, with the objective of ensuring an appropriate level of information security in the provision of services to the company's customers in the fields of:

Development, manufacturing, and marketing of diagnostic kits for pathogen detection, as well as laboratory services for genomic sequencing and molecular biology.

Accordingly, company management commits to:

- Protect information assets, including private and medical information databases of the company's customers, and ensure the availability, integrity, and reliability of information, including medical information to which the company has access.
- Allocate the necessary resources for the operation and maintenance of the company's Information Security Management System (ISMS).
- Define objectives and targets within the Information Security Management System.
- Maintain a process of continual improvement and evaluation of the effectiveness of the Information Security Management System.
- Increase employee awareness regarding information security.
- Conduct activities in compliance with applicable legal and regulatory requirements related to information security.
- Base the Information Security Management System on a structured risk identification and management methodology, aimed at minimizing and preventing risks affecting information repositories and company assets.
- Implement logical and physical security controls to prevent unauthorized access to information.
- Recognize human resources as a critical component in enhancing the level of information security, and therefore establish mechanisms for employee reliability screening and ongoing awareness training in information security matters.
